This implementation guide is intended to enable a receiver of a functional group based on an X12 Implementation Guideline (TR3) related to Health Care Insurance business processes, to report syntactical errors as specified by that transaction's implementation guideline (TR3), or to acknowledge receipt of an error-free transaction set.
